Never mind, I don't want to give away the ending.

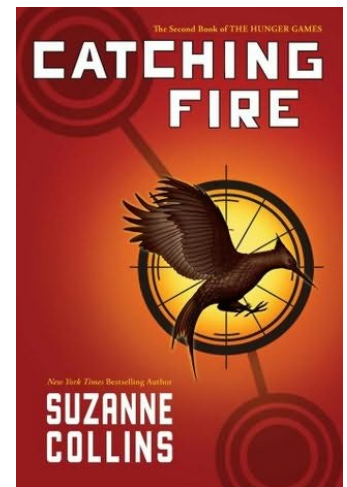
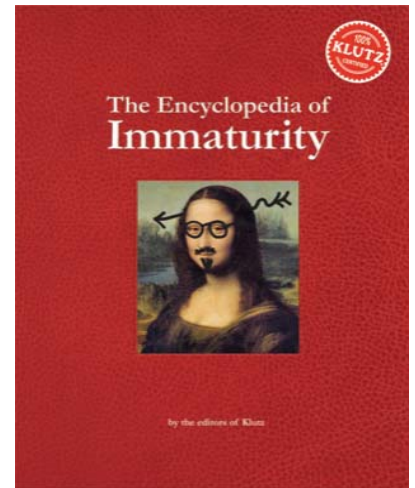
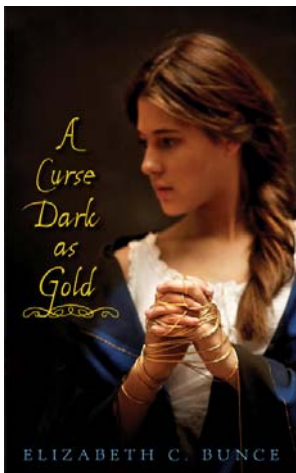
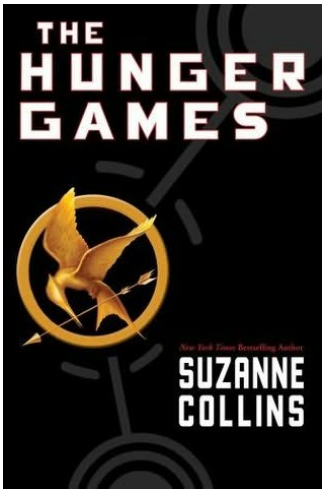
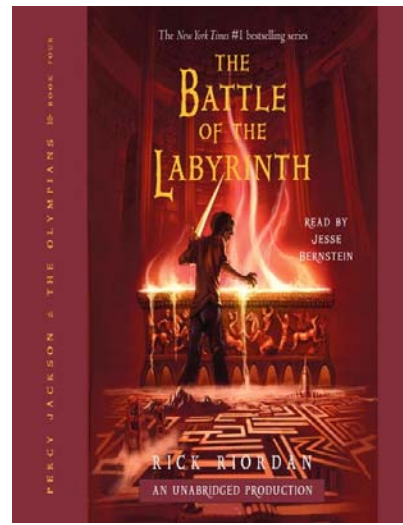
